

## VINTAGE IN REVIEW

2016 provided ample moisture in the spring, getting the vines off to an early start. The weather turned warm and dry with bright sunshine for the remainder of the season, which frequently happens here in the Mid-Atlantic. As September arrived, the weather turned cool, which is ideal for the final ripening of fruit. The Sauvignon Blanc reached extremely high levels of ripeness allowing for greater weight in the wine and richer fruits.
